

Would you like to run a *Score Lines* live event in your area?

Let me give you an idea of what's involved...

If you'd like to help me plan an event in your area these are the things *you* can help with:

Suggest a venue. This could be a village hall or community centre. It needs to be big enough to seat around 40 recorder players, with parking nearby and toilets. The venue also needs a kitchen area to make teas and coffees – after all, recorder playing is thirsty work!

If you're able to book the venue for me I'll reimburse the cost of the hall hire, but I'm just as happy to book it myself if you can provide the necessary information.

You'll need to provide the ingredients for teas and coffees on the day, plus a supply of biscuits and/or cakes for break times. I can provide information about how much you'll need buy and any costs will be reimbursed.

Please do all you can to spread the work among local recorder players.

None of these tasks need to be done by just one person – you're welcome to share the work among a small team!

These are the things I will do:

Come along and conduct, supplying the music, inspiration and entertainment!

Publicity on my website and in *Score Lines*, as well as advertising the event via the Society of Recorder Players and on social media.

Take bookings, deal with the finances of the event and send out information to everyone who wants to come along.

How much does a *Score Lines* LIVE playing day cost?

The cost for participants is £20 for the day's playing, with all music and teas/coffees included. The income from the participants pays for the hall hire, refreshments, music printing and my professional fee so there's no financial risk for people who choose to help me organise a day.
